

Temple Chambers Moot 2022

We are pleased to announce the inaugural Temple Chambers Moot, to be held at Chambers on Saturday, 27th August 2022. The moot is open to all undergraduate students reading law and Juris Doctor candidates at universities in Hong Kong or abroad. Students will moot against each other in teams on novel and as-yet unresolved points of Hong Kong law.

The final round of the Moot will be judged by three current members of Temple Chambers: the Hon Geoffrey Ma, former Chief Justice of the Hong Kong Court of Final Appeal, Paul Shieh SC, Head of Chambers, and Bernard Man SC.
